unparalleled importance to the history of the Hawaiian Kingdom,

preservation of such a foundational landmark requires sustained  
commitment and public recognition. This measure commemorates the  
fiftieth anniversary of the successful community-led restoration  
of Ahu'ena Heiau, a significant achievement in historic  
preservation that further perpetuates Hawaii's culture.
