<p><u>SB 3248, SD1</u> (SSCR2385) Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO LABELING REQUIREMENTS. Establishes labeling requirements for ?okolehao products. Effective 9/9/2129. (SD1)</p>	<p>HWN, CPN</p>
