Kualapu'u School: A Public Conversion Charter, Kualapu'u, HI

Support the principal, or as principal, oversee all school operations for this PreK-6th grade school, which includes a Hawaiian Language Immersion Program. Assist with curriculum and instruction, guide and provide student support services and discipline, including special needs students and counseling, track student learning and assessment, provide supervision and evaluation of employees, assist with recruitment of employees and lead committees such as accreditation or the solutions network, partner or liaison with community organizations such as Maui Police Dept. and Healthy Alliance, and oversee smaller grants and budgeting.
