My name is Miles Ino and I strongly support the re-appointment of Robyn Jumawan to the State of Hawaii Boxing Commission.

I have known Ms. Jumawan since 2020. It was in that year I was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease, a degenerative movement disorder which can cause deterioration of motor skills, balance, speech and sensory function. Ms. Jumawan was instrumental in developing the Rock Steady Boxing Affiliate Program at Pearlside Boxing Gym under the direction of Coach Eiichi Jumawan, who is one of just a few certified Rock Steady Boxing trainers in Hawaii. The mission of Rock Steady Boxing is to improve the quality of life of people with Parkinson's disease through a non-contact, boxing-based fitness curriculum.

Ms. Jumawan's outstanding character and sincere desire to help others achieve goals beyond their expectations are an invaluable asset to the sport of boxing. Her tireless commitment to boxing is evident to everyone who meets and works with her. Her attention to detail, keen problem solving skills, and deep understanding of boxing and physical development are a priceless asset to the sport and the Boxing
