Honorable Chair Angus McKelvey, Vice Chair Mike Gabbard, and Committee Members, thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony on GM 785.



I support Captain Stacy Perreira for the position on the 9-1-1 Board.

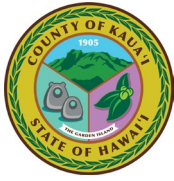

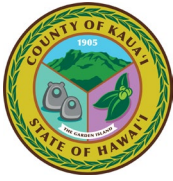

On behalf of the Kaua'i Police Department, I am writing to express our **strong support** for Gubernatorial Nominee Stacy Perreira to the 911 Board as the Kaua'i Police Department's Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Representative.

Stacy Perreira is currently a Police Captain with the Kaua'i Police Department and she is the subject matter expert relating to PSAP operations, computer aided dispatching (CAD) and related technologies. Captain Perreira was assigned to the KPD PSAP in 2016, at the time a Sergeant, where she made a concerted effort to understand dispatch operations, identify dispatcher needs, and explore ways the department could enhance and support their working environment both through technology and by promoting overall health and well-being.

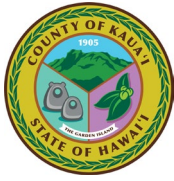

I am writing in **strong support** of Gubernatorial Nominee Stacy Perreira for appointment to the 911 Board as the department's Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Representative.

Captain Stacy Perreira has direct, hands-on experience with the operational demands of emergency communications. Since her assignment to the KPD PSAP in 2016, she has worked closely with dispatch personnel to better understand workflow challenges, call handling demands, and system limitations. Her approach has consistently emphasized practical improvements—ensuring dispatchers are supported with reliable technology, efficient processes, and a work environment that allows them to perform at a high level under demanding conditions.

Her background in overseeing Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management Systems (RMS) has been critical to maintaining continuity of operations within the department. As the primary system administrator for multiple CAD and RMS platforms since 2002, Captain Perreira has been directly involved in system implementation, maintenance, and troubleshooting, ensuring minimal disruption to critical services. If confirmed to the 911 Board, Captain Perreira will bring a strong operational perspective, with a focus on system reliability, interoperability, and consistency across PSAPs statewide. She understands the importance of standardized procedures, ongoing training, and maintaining modern, functional systems that support both dispatchers and first responders in the field. Her experience positions her to contribute meaningfully to discussions on improving statewide emergency communications infrastructure.
