RELATING TO HOUSING

House Bill 2362 requires the counties to automatically approve permits for hurricane retrofitting under certain conditions, **The Hawai'i Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission (Commission) supports this measure.**

The Commission consists of a multi-jurisdictional effort between 20 departments, committees, and counties with the purpose of promoting ambitious, climate-neutral, culturally responsive strategies for climate change adaptation and mitigation.

Retrofitting Hawai'i's ageing housing stock is vital as climate change causes more frequent and severe storms. According to the University of Hawai'i's Department of Atmospheric Sciences, climate change will also shift hurricane tracks northward. At present, the main tracks generally stay to the south of Hawai'i. Hurricane clips can be an inexpensive, quick way to protect a home from high winds without changing the footprint of the home. Automatic permitting for these types of retrofits will reduce barriers to installation demands on permitting offices.
