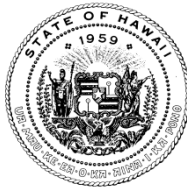

DIMENSIONS ON A SEGMENT OF KAMEHAMEHA V HIGHWAY ON MOLOKAI TO

The Department of Transportation (HDOT) supports HR58 and HCR 64 and appreciates the intent to improve roadway safety while addressing community concerns.

HDOT recognizes that while rumble strips are an important safety countermeasure, their design must be appropriate for the specific roadway context. Adjusting rumble strip dimensions along Kamehameha V Highway on Moloka'i to reduce unintended hazards and noise impacts is a reasonable and balanced approach.

HDOT is committed to evaluating appropriate design modifications that maintain safety benefits while minimizing impacts to nearby residents and roadway users.
