

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2600, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the General Fund," passed by the Legislature, was presented to the Governor within the aforementioned period; and

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of Article III, the Governor may veto any specific item or items, except for items to be expended by the Legislative and Judicial Branches, in any bill that appropriates money for specific purposes by striking out or reducing the same; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2600 appropriates money for specific purposes and certain appropriations in that bill are unacceptable to the Governor of the State of Hawai'i;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSH GREEN, M.D., Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby issue this proclamation, pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, giving notice of my plan to return Senate Bill No. 2600 with my objections to certain appropriation items contained therein to the Legislature as provided by said Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution.
