
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY ANNOUNCEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§127A- State of emergency; official announcements;
5 American Sign Language interpreter; requirements. (a) Whenever
6 the governor or mayor, as applicable, declares a state of
7 emergency pursuant to this chapter, the governor or mayor shall
8 provide an American Sign Language interpreter who is certified
9 by a nationally or state recognized credentialing authority at
10 each live broadcast press conference during the state of
11 emergency. To the greatest extent possible, the governor or
12 mayor shall ensure that the American Sign Language interpreter
13 is physically positioned in a manner so that the interpreter's
14 face, body, arms, and hands are always visible during a
15 television or internet broadcast of the press conference.

16 (b) The governor or mayor, as applicable, shall provide a
17 primary pool feed for any live official announcement that



1 includes an American Sign Language interpreter in a picture-in-
2 picture window. A broadcaster that rebroadcasts the official
3 announcement shall not be required to independently generate or
4 insert this accessibility feature."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Emergency; Official Announcements; Broadcast Media; American Sign Language; Sign Language Interpreter

Description:

Requires the Governor or mayor of a county to provide an American Sign Language interpreter during each official announcement broadcast via television or the Internet during a state of emergency. Requires the Governor or mayor of a county to ensure, to the fullest extent possible, that the American Sign Language interpreter's face, body, arms, and hands are visible during the broadcast. Requires the Governor or mayor of a county to provide a primary pool feed for any live official announcement that includes an American Sign Language interpreter in a picture-in-picture window, and does not require broadcasters that rebroadcast the official announcement to independently generate or insert this accessibility feature. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
