
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to promote products
2 manufactured in Hawaii; expand the export of Hawaii-made goods;
3 attract foreign and domestic investment and commercial activity
4 to the State; foster sister-state, educational, athletic, and
5 cultural exchanges; and advance initiatives that yield economic
6 benefits for Hawaii by:

- 7 (1) Expanding the purposes of the establishment and
8 operation of out-of-state offices to include
9 collaboration with tourism agencies and stakeholders
10 to execute tourism strategies;
- 11 (2) Requiring and appropriating funds for the department
12 of business, economic development, and tourism to
13 establish an out-of-state office in Seoul, Republic of
14 Korea; and
- 15 (3) Appropriating funds for the department of business,
16 economic development, and tourism's Beijing,
17 Philippines, and Taipei offices to promote "Made in



1 Hawaii" branded products and increase the export of
2 Hawaii products.

3 SECTION 2. Section 201-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "**§201-81 Establishment of out-of-state offices; purposes.**

6 The department of business, economic development, and tourism
7 may establish and operate offices and facilities in out-of-state
8 locations, including foreign nations, to effectuate the
9 following purposes:

- 10 (1) Develop programs to reach targeted companies or
11 industries in the respective area and surrounding
12 regions;
- 13 (2) Monitor out-of-state government policies and
14 regulations that have an impact on business, markets,
15 sales, tourism, and related activities;
- 16 (3) Host government and business officials at conferences,
17 meetings and social occasions, or other events on
18 matters pertaining to business opportunities and
19 attraction of investments for the State;



- 1 (4) Develop and conduct advertising efforts, promotional
- 2 events, media coverage, and educational programs
- 3 regarding commerce in the State;
- 4 (5) Conduct related operations as needed, including hiring
- 5 or contracting for consultants;
- 6 (6) Support sister-state or province relationships, as
- 7 defined in section 229-1, and other partnerships that
- 8 promote and enrich the people, cultures, environments,
- 9 and economies of the State and its international
- 10 partners; [~~and~~]
- 11 (7) Collaborate with tourism agencies and stakeholders to
- 12 execute tourism strategies; and
- 13 [~~(7)~~] (8) Generate revenue for the State."

14 SECTION 3. The department of business, economic
 15 development, and tourism shall establish an out-of-state office
 16 in Seoul, Republic of Korea, as authorized under section 201-81,
 17 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

18 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for



1 the department of business, economic development, and tourism to
2 establish an out-of-state office in Seoul, Republic of Korea.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
5 this Act.

6 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for
9 the department of business, economic development, and tourism's
10 Beijing, Philippines, and Taipei offices to promote "Made in
11 Hawaii" branded products and increase the export of Hawaii
12 products.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
15 this Act.

16 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Expands the purposes of the establishment and operation of out-of-state offices to include collaboration with tourism agencies and stakeholders to execute tourism strategies. Requires, and appropriates funds for, the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to establish an out-of-state office in Seoul, Republic of Korea. Appropriates funds for the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism's Beijing, Philippines, and Taipei offices to promote "Made in Hawaii" branded products and increase the export of Hawaii products.
