
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii is unique
2 among all other states in the nation for having driver's license
3 and motor vehicle application systems managed and operated by a
4 county within the state instead of having a state managed and
5 operated application system. This arrangement has its roots in
6 the earliest days of statehood and the unique make-up of the
7 four counties of the State.

8 The legislature further finds that the application system
9 currently being managed and operated by the city and county of
10 Honolulu was developed in the 1970s and operates on a system of
11 code that has become increasingly antiquated and that hinders
12 further development and maintenance of this system due to its
13 outdated technology. Furthermore, the current application
14 system is operated on a mainframe hosted by the city and county
15 of Honolulu that itself is becoming increasingly outdated.



1 The legislature finds that the upgrade of the existing
2 application system will increase efficiency of operations,
3 enable easier access to these systems by the departments of
4 motor vehicles and law enforcement which access this
5 information, and will reduce maintenance costs by switching from
6 a physical mainframe maintained by the city and county of
7 Honolulu to a cloud-based service.

8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide a
9 grant-in-aid to the department of information technology of the
10 city and county of Honolulu for the upgrade of this vital
11 system.

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 as a
15 grant-in-aid to the department of information technology of the
16 city and county of Honolulu for the implementation of upgrades
17 to the driver's license and motor vehicle application systems;
18 provided that no funds shall be expended unless the city and
19 county of Honolulu provides matching funds on a dollar-for-
20 dollar basis for the purpose for which this sum is appropriated.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 information technology of the city and county of Honolulu for
3 the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
