# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LAND TRANSFER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022 (Act 307),  
2 directed the conveyance to the department of education of the  
3 fee simple title to certain lands owned by the department of  
4 land and natural resources, county of Kauai, and county of Maui.  
5 Since that time, further verification of information and changes  
6 in circumstances require the revision of tax map key numbers  
7 provided in Act 307.

8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:

9 (1) Revise certain tax map key numbers set forth in  
10 section 2 of Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, for  
11 accuracy or due to a change in circumstances; and  
12 (2) Revise the process by which properties were, or may in  
13 the future, be conveyed to the department of education  
14 pursuant to Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022.

15 SECTION 2. Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is  
16 amended by amending section 2 to read as follows:



1       "SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the  
2 contrary, the fee simple interest to the parcels of land set  
3 forth in this section, together with the existing improvements  
4 thereon, but not including submerged land, accreted land, or any  
5 land makai of the legal shoreline (collectively, the  
6 properties), shall be conveyed by their respective owner or  
7 owners to the department of education as grantee, as is, where  
8 is. The department of education shall accept the properties in  
9 their existing condition. All claims and liabilities against  
10 the grantors, if any, that the department of education has, may  
11 have had, or may have in the future, regarding any injury, loss,  
12 cost, damage, or liability, including reasonable attorney's  
13 fees, concerning the physical, environmental, soil, economic,  
14 and legal conditions of the properties, shall be released,  
15 waived, and extinguished.

16       (b) The transfer of the properties pursuant to this Act  
17 shall be effective by operation of law as of July 1, 2022. The  
18 respective owner or owners of the properties shall prepare,  
19 execute, and record, in the ~~[land court or bureau of~~  
20 ~~conveyances,]~~ office of the assistant registrar of the land  
21 court of the State of Hawaii or the State of Hawaii bureau of



1 conveyances, as appropriate, a quitclaim deed [to convey each  
2 ~~eff~~] or other conveyance instrument to evidence and formally  
3 document the conveyance of each of the properties together with  
4 all existing improvements. [Work to initiate the conveyance of  
5 the properties shall commence no later than December 31, 2022.  
6 As an alternative to conveyance instruments for each parcel of  
7 state or county owned land, the transfer of such lands shall be  
8 completed by operation of law.] Where applicable and in the  
9 discretion of the department of education, the department of  
10 education may elect to obtain all or a portion of each parcel  
11 identified by this Act. If the department of education elects  
12 to obtain a portion or portions of any parcel identified by this  
13 Act, then the parties to the conveyance shall take all actions  
14 necessary to legally effect the same.

15 (c) As these are conveyances in which the county and the  
16 State and its agencies are the only parties, the tax imposed by  
17 section 247-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall not apply.

18 (d) Effective [on the date of transfer,] as of July 1,  
19 2022, every reference to the titleholder of the properties shall  
20 be construed as a reference to the department of education[-]  
21 irrespective of whether a quitclaim deed or other conveyance



1 document has been recorded in the office of the assistant  
2 registrar of the land court of the State of Hawaii or the State  
3 bureau of conveyances, as applicable.
