# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLE SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation may  
2     implement a pilot program for mobile vehicle safety inspections  
3     that allows mobile vehicle safety inspections for passenger cars  
4     to be conducted at any location determined by the vehicle owner  
5     and inspector; provided that each county shall have one  
6     participating operator who is authorized to conduct mobile  
7     vehicle safety inspections; provided further that for any county  
8     that consists of more than one island, there shall be one  
9     participating operator who is authorized to conduct mobile  
10    vehicle safety inspections per island.

11           (b) The director of transportation may:

12           (1) Appoint up to three inspectors to support the pilot  
13           program; and

14           (2) Raise the price of the mobile vehicle safety  
15           inspections as part of the pilot program.

16           (c) The department of transportation may adopt rules  
17     necessary for the implementation of the pilot program.



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000;  
2 provided that:

3 (1) The pilot program established pursuant to section 1 of  
4 this Act shall commence one hundred twenty days after  
5 the effective date of this Act; and

6 (2) The pilot program shall be repealed on June 30, 2030.
