
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU DEPARTMENT OF PARKS
AND RECREATION TO INSTALL PERMANENT PICKLEBALL NETS AND
COURT LIGHTING AT THE TENNIS COURTS AT KAMILO'IKI COMMUNITY
PARK.

1 WHEREAS, Kamilo'iki Community Park in Hawaii Kai serves as
2 an important recreational gathering place for residents of East
3 Honolulu and provides facilities for tennis, pickleball, and
4 other community activities; and

5
6 WHEREAS, pickleball has rapidly grown into one of the most
7 popular recreational sports in the United States, attracting
8 participants of all ages due to its accessibility, social
9 nature, and relatively low-impact physical activity; and

10
11 WHEREAS, according to the Sports and Fitness Industry
12 Association's Topline Participation Report, approximately 19.8
13 million Americans played pickleball in 2024, representing a 45.8
14 percent increase from the previous year and more than a 300
15 percent increase over three years, making it the fastest-growing
16 sport in the United States; and

18 WHEREAS, the sport's popularity has created increased
19 demand for courts nationwide, with tens of thousands of
20 dedicated pickleball courts now in operation across the country
21 and many communities converting existing tennis facilities to
22 accommodate pickleball play; and

24 WHEREAS, Kamilo'iki Community Park has become a popular
25 location for pickleball play, particularly among kupuna and
26 other residents seeking accessible and social forms of physical
27 activity; and

1 WHEREAS, players currently must bring and set up their own
2 temporary nets each time they wish to play pickleball at the
3 park, which can create logistical challenges and limit
4 opportunities for spontaneous recreational use; and

5
6 WHEREAS, installing permanent pickleball nets would
7 significantly improve accessibility and convenience for
8 residents, encourage greater participation in healthy outdoor
9 recreation, and help meet growing demand for pickleball
10 facilities in East Honolulu; and

11
12 WHEREAS, the tennis courts at Kamilo'iki Community Park
13 currently do not have court lighting, requiring players to stop
14 playing once daylight ends, even when weather conditions and
15 community demand would otherwise allow continued recreational
16 use; and

17
18 WHEREAS, installing lighting at the courts would allow
19 residents to safely enjoy recreational activities during evening
20 hours, particularly during shorter winter days and after normal
21 working hours; and

22
23 WHEREAS, expanding recreational opportunities at existing
24 park facilities can help promote physical health, strengthen
25 community connections, and ensure that public parks continue to
26 serve residents of all ages; now, therefore,

27
28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
29 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
30 of 2026, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of
31 Honolulu Department of Parks and Recreation is requested to
32 install permanent pickleball nets and court lighting at the
33 tennis courts located at Kamilo'iki Community Park; and

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Parks and
36 Recreation is encouraged to consult with community members and
37 park users regarding the design, placement, and number of
38 pickleball courts and lighting improvements necessary to best
39 serve the needs of the surrounding community; and

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
42 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
