# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO STUDENTS ON HOW TO PREREGISTER TO VOTE PRIOR TO REACHING VOTING AGE.

1 WHEREAS, civic participation is fundamental to a healthy  
2 democracy and that young adults aged eighteen to twenty-four  
3 represent a growing portion of Hawaii's electorate; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, according to the United States Census Bureau,  
6 fewer than forty per cent of young adults participated in state  
7 elections from 2014 to 2024; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, voting at a young age creates and empowers  
10 lifelong voters, as data shows that after an individual votes  
11 once, the individual often becomes a habitual voter; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, this lack of participation is primarily the result  
14 of informational and time barriers, which have pronounced  
15 effects on youth from low-income backgrounds, who are twice as  
16 likely to miss registration deadlines or run out of time; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, by making information on voter preregistration and  
19 registration more accessible for people sixteen years of age and  
20 older, the State can empower a new generation of lifelong  
21 voters; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, public schools, including charter schools, are  
24 excellent venues for preregistering and registering students to  
25 vote, since schools already require participation in a democracy  
26 and civics class for graduation, and therefore have the  
27 foundation to help increase civic engagement; now, therefore,

29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
30 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session



1 of 2026, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Education  
2 provide information to students on how to preregister to vote  
3 prior to reaching voting age; and  
4

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is  
6 urged to provide specific information regarding:  
7

8 (1) Voting eligibility information and guidance published  
9 by the office of elections;  
10

11 (2) Procedures for properly completing and submitting a  
12 voter registration application to the Hawaii online  
13 voter registration system, the appropriate county  
14 clerk, or through other lawful means;  
15

16 (3) Information on opportunities to register to vote; and  
17

18 (4) Information on opportunities for students sixteen  
19 years of age or older to volunteer at a voter service  
20 center, including information on how to sign up  
21 through the office of elections website; and  
22

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education  
24 make available paper copies of voter registration and  
25 preregistration application forms; and  
26

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education  
28 make available resources describing accessible voting options  
29 and accommodations to students who require assistance to vote  
30 due to a disability, visual or hearing impairment, or inability  
31 to read or write; and  
32

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education  
34 designate the last two full weeks in September of each year as  
35 "high school voter registration and preregistration weeks",  
36 which shall include activities to:  
37

38 (1) Raise civic awareness among high school students;

40 (2) Encourage eligible students ages sixteen or seventeen  
41 to preregister or register to vote; and

1 (3) Include, to the extent available, state or county  
2 election employees or officials who can preregister  
3 and register students at school personnel campuses;

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this

8 Education.
