COMMENDING AND HONORING ALAN JOHNSON FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO
ADDRESSING SUBSTANCE AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ISSUES THROUGH
HINA MAUKA.

1 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives takes great pride in
2 recognizing visionary leaders whose work has transformed the
3 lives of thousands and strengthened the fabric of our
4 communities; and

6 WHEREAS, ALAN JOHNSON has served Hina Mauka for nearly
7 three decades in various capacities, including as its COO, CFO,
8 Managing Director, President, and CEO, guiding the organization
9 through decades of growth and innovation and establishing it as
10 a cornerstone of substance use and behavioral health treatment
11 in Hawai'i by providing services to over 70,000 individuals; and

13 WHEREAS, under ALAN JOHNSON's leadership, Hina Mauka
14 expanded services across the islands, introduced evidence-based
15 therapies, such as cognitive behavioral therapy and motivational
16 interviewing, and pioneered integrated care models that
17 addressed co-occurring mental health and substance use

20 WHEREAS, ALAN JOHNSON has championed treatment programs for
21 women, adolescents, and Native Hawaiian communities, has
22 inspired a statewide commitment to school-based prevention
23 services, and was instrumental in forming the Hawaii Substance
24 Abuse Coalition; and


