## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the number of  
2 traffic accidents and deaths on the Daniel K. Inouye highway is  
3 alarming. The legislature notes that the Hawaii police  
4 department reported that a significant majority of excessive  
5 speed citations and arrests this year have occurred along the  
6 Daniel K. Inouye Highway, evidencing the ongoing danger  
7 associated with speeding and reckless behavior on this roadway.

8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to adopt a uniform  
9 maximum speed limit of fifty-five miles per hour along the  
10 entire length of the highway.

11 SECTION 2. Section 291C-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 **"[+]§291C-106[+] Speed limit for Daniel K. Inouye highway.**  
14 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the maximum speed  
15 limit for the Daniel K. Inouye highway shall be [sixty]  
16 fifty-five miles per hour ~~[beginning at mile marker 12; provided~~  
17 ~~that the speed limit shall be forty-five miles per hour or any~~



1 ~~other speed limit as determined pursuant to sections 291C-102,~~  
2 ~~291C-104, or 291C-105, beginning at the Pohakuloa training area~~  
3 ~~and ending one half mile east of the Mauna Kea county park~~  
4 ~~entrance]. "~~

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
