
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 139, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§139- Federal law enforcement collaboration;
5 prohibited. (a) Except as required by federal or state law, no
6 law enforcement officer shall use any personnel or funds
7 originating in the State to assist or facilitate conduct by
8 federal immigration agents that exceeds their law enforcement
9 duty or authority.

10 (b) Except as required by federal or state law, no law
11 enforcement officer shall assist or cooperate with; or allow
12 time, money, facilities, property, equipment, personnel, or
13 other resources to be used to facilitate federal immigration
14 agents in an operation that seeks to identify, arrest, or impose
15 any other criminal or civil penalty on a person or entity for:

16 (1) Activities protected by the First Amendment of the
17 United States Constitution; or



1 (2) Immigration enforcement purposes, including
2 immigration enforcement that occurs at or near a
3 school, health facility, place of worship, or
4 courthouse."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Description:

Prohibits law enforcement officers from using any personnel or funds originating in the State to assist or facilitate conduct by federal immigration agents that exceeds their law enforcement duty or authority. Prohibits law enforcement officers from assisting or cooperating with or allowing resources to be used to facilitate federal immigration agents engaged in operations that target individuals or entities for activities protected by the First Amendment of the United States Constitution or immigration enforcement operations. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
