
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEIGHBORHOOD BOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 92-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) A quorum for a meeting of a neighborhood board or
4 community outreach board shall be required for:

5 (1) Conducting official board business;

6 (2) Discussions before and related to voting; and

7 (3) Voting required to validate an act of the board as
8 part of official board business[-];

9 provided that, if a neighborhood board overseen by a
10 neighborhood commission of the city and county of Honolulu has a
11 vacancy, notwithstanding section 92-15, a majority of the filled
12 seats on the neighborhood board shall constitute a quorum for
13 conducting official board business and discussions before and
14 related to voting, and the concurrence of a majority of the
15 members present at a meeting at which quorum is established
16 shall be necessary to validate any act of the board as part of
17 official board business.



1 A neighborhood board or community outreach board may
2 receive information or testimony on a matter of official board
3 business without a quorum; provided that the board shall not
4 make a decision on the issue. The board members, at the next
5 meeting of the board, shall report the matters presented as
6 information or testimony."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.



Report Title:

Neighborhood Boards; Vacancies; Quorum Requirements

Description:

Establishes that when a neighborhood board of the City and County of Honolulu has a vacancy, a majority of the filled seats shall constitute quorum for conducting business and a majority vote of the members present at the board's meeting shall validate an act of the board as part of its official business. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
