# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3           "(e) No driver's license shall be renewed by the examiner  
4 of drivers unless:

5           (1) The examiner of drivers is satisfied of the  
6 applicant's fitness to continue to operate a motor  
7 vehicle;

8           (2) If the applicant has received two or more traffic  
9           citations for violations of a state traffic law or  
10           county traffic ordinance involving the operation of a  
11           motor vehicle within the five years preceding the date  
12           that the applicant files for renewal, the applicant  
13           completes an educational course that includes:

14           (A) An online road safety video developed by the  
15           department of transportation; and

16           (B) A written road safety examination that tests an  
17           applicant's:



- 1                    (i) Ability to understand highway signs
- 2                    regulating, warning, and directing traffic;
- 3                    (ii) Knowledge of the rules of the road based on
- 4                    the state traffic laws and county traffic
- 5                    ordinances where the applicant resides or
- 6                    intends to operate a motor vehicle,
- 7                    including any new or amended state traffic
- 8                    laws and county traffic ordinances;
- 9                    (iii) Knowledge and understanding of information
- 10                   relating to driver safety and collision
- 11                   reduction as determined by the department;
- 12                   and
- 13                   (iv) Any other knowledge of the rules of the road
- 14                   that the department of transportation deems
- 15                   necessary to determine the applicant's
- 16                   fitness to continue to operate a motor
- 17                   vehicle;

18        [~~2~~] (3) The fee required by subsection (d) is tendered  
 19                   together with the application for renewal;

20        [~~3~~] (4) The applicant complies with section 286-102.5;  
 21                   and



1        [~~4~~] (5)    The examiner of drivers is satisfied that the  
2                    applicant does not have outstanding charges and fines  
3                    relating to the disposition of an abandoned vehicle."

4        SECTION 2.    Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken.    New statutory material is underscored.

6        SECTION 3.    This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.



**Report Title:**

DOT; Traffic Safety; Driver's License; Renewal; Motor Vehicle Drivers

**Description:**

Requires applicants for driver's license renewal who have received two or more traffic citations within the preceding five years for violations involving the operation of a motor vehicle to complete an educational course that includes a road safety video developed by the Department of Transportation and a written road safety examination. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
