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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LAND DISPOSITIONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The board of land and natural resources  
2 shall extend the term of all leases of public lands to the  
3 United States military that expire in 2028, 2029, 2030, or 2031  
4 for a period of five years, to allow the military additional  
5 time to complete and submit an environmental impact statement  
6 pursuant to chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the leased  
7 public lands; provided that the accepting authority of the final  
8 statement shall be the governor, or the governor's authorized  
9 representative.

10           (b) For the purposes of this section:

11           "Environmental impact statement" has the same meaning as  
12 defined in section 343-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

13           "Lease" has the same meaning as defined in section 171-1,  
14 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

15           "Public lands" has the same meaning as defined in  
16 section 171-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
