A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 139, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§139- State deputization; generalized policing. (a) A
5 law enforcement officer may request assistance from a federal
6 law enforcement officer in the case of a law enforcement
7 emergency as defined in title 34 United States Code section
8 50102 or to prevent substantial risk of death or serious
9 physical injury to another person.

10 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a state employee or
11 law enforcement officer shall not request assistance from a
12 federal law enforcement officer to enforce state laws, including
13 the following:

- 14 (1) Temporary or predetermined checkpoints or screenings;
15 and
16 (2) Motor vehicle stops.

Report Title:

Federal Law Enforcement; Generalized Policing; State Law Enforcement; Requests for Assistance

Description:

Prohibits a law enforcement officer and law enforcement agency from making certain requests for assistance from federal law enforcement agencies with exceptions. Establishes requirements and limitations for law enforcement agencies to enter into agreements with federal law enforcement agencies.
