# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 353C-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending its title and subsections (a) and (b) to  
3 read as follows:

4           "~~{}~~§353C-16~~{}~~ **Agricultural enforcement [~~pi~~lot] program.**

5           (a) There shall be established within the department an  
6 agricultural enforcement [~~pi~~lot] program [~~on the islands of Oahu~~  
7 ~~and Hawaii,~~] in the State to be implemented at the discretion of  
8 the deputy director of law enforcement. The department shall  
9 employ or appoint, and remove, the following persons, subject to  
10 chapter 76 and section 78-1:

11           (1) An assistant chief, who shall be the administrator of  
12 the agricultural enforcement [~~pi~~lot] program and shall  
13 have charge, direction, and control, subject to the  
14 direction or control of the deputy director, of all  
15 matters relating to the enforcement of an offense  
16 listed in section 708-835.55 involving theft of an  
17 agricultural product or commodity and any other

1 matters as determined by the deputy director. The  
2 assistant chief shall be an administrator experienced  
3 in addressing agricultural theft; and

4 (2) Personnel, state law enforcement officers, and  
5 investigators, including but not limited to state law  
6 enforcement officers serving on a voluntary basis  
7 without pay.

8 (b) In addition to all police powers and duties, state law  
9 enforcement officers in the agricultural enforcement [~~pilot~~]  
10 program shall:

11 (1) Focus on offenses under sections 708-830.5, 708-831,  
12 708-832, and 708-833 that involve the theft of an  
13 agricultural product or commodity;

14 (2) Gather evidence, conduct investigations, and conduct  
15 field observations, as required or assigned;

16 (3) Cooperate with any enforcement authorities of the  
17 federal, state, or county government in the  
18 development of programs and mutual aid agreements for  
19 agricultural activities within the State; and

20 (4) Carry out other duties and responsibilities as  
21 determined by the deputy director."



1 SECTION 2. Act 235, Session Laws of Hawaii 2025, is  
2 amended by amending section 47 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 47. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025[+  
4 ~~provided that part II of this Act shall be repealed on July 1,~~  
5 ~~2028]."~~

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
