# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIQUOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that experiential  
2 learning and hands-on training are essential to prepare students  
3 for careers in culinary arts, hospitality, and related fields.  
4 The legislature recognizes that work in these fields may  
5 occasionally involve cooking with or serving alcohol.  
6 Incorporating liquor into appropriate educational settings may  
7 therefore be helpful for enhancing student learning, skill  
8 development, and industry-relevant training. The legislature  
9 also recognizes that other educational settings, like libraries,  
10 may sometimes benefit from incorporating liquor into  
11 exhibitions.

12           Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to authorize state  
13 libraries and the university of Hawaii and its campuses to  
14 utilize liquor in certain educational settings, under certain  
15 conditions, without obtaining a liquor license.



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 **"§281- Liquor; limited license exemption.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or any other  
6 law to the contrary, the following entities may utilize liquor  
7 without obtaining a liquor license under part III; provided that  
8 liquor shall not be consumed by persons under the age of twenty-  
9 one:

- 10 (1) The university of Hawaii and its campuses, solely to  
11 support education and training in culinary arts,  
12 hospitality, or a related field of study; provided  
13 further that liquor may be sold to the general public  
14 if incidental to the educational programs; provided  
15 further that any student or staff member selling  
16 liquor to the public shall complete liquor commission-  
17 approved server training; and
- 18 (2) State libraries that are not located on department of  
19 education property or near public schools, as provided  
20 in applicable rules and laws, solely for the purposes



1           of an educational exhibition; provided further that  
2           liquor shall not be sold to the general public."

3           SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
5 begun before its effective date.

6           SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

7           SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
