
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of human services shall set
2 the minimum certification periods for supplemental nutrition
3 assistance program benefits households to twelve months;
4 provided that for households in which all adult members are
5 sixty years of age or older, the certification periods shall be
6 twenty-four months at a minimum.

7 (b) The department of human services shall participate in
8 the elderly simplified application project of the supplemental
9 nutrition assistance program to simplify eligibility
10 determinations for eligible households. Participation in the
11 elderly simplified application project shall include:

12 (1) Establishing recertification periods of at least
13 thirty-six months for households composed entirely of
14 adults sixty years of age or older or adults with
15 disabilities; and

16 (2) Waiving the recertification interview for eligible
17 households, to the extent allowed by federal law.



1 (c) The department of human services shall seek any
2 necessary federal approvals or waivers to implement this Act and
3 shall promptly amend its rules, policies, and procedures to
4 effectuate the intent of this Act.

5 (d) The department of human services shall submit reports
6 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
7 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
8 to the convening of the regular sessions of 2029 and 2030. The
9 reports shall include:

- 10 (1) Data on the implementation and utilization of the
11 supplemental nutrition assistance program and elderly
12 simplified application project, including the number
13 and characteristics of participating households;
- 14 (2) Administrative cost savings or changes; and
- 15 (3) Analysis of the participation rates.

16 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on January 30, 2050;
17 provided that section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2028.
