SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION TO ESTABLISH A COORDINATED DATA ENTRY SYSTEM FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION AND COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENTS AND PROSECUTORS TO TRACK THE STATUS OF DETAINEES INCARCERATED IN DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION FACILITIES.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation
2 (DCR) publishes an annual report containing critical statistics
3 on the State's criminal justice system, including aggregated
4 data on detainees; and

5
6 WHEREAS, the data contained in the report document types of
7 crimes committed, length of pretrial detention, reasons for
8 pretrial release, and many other metrics for evaluating the
9 status of detainees; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the data contained in DCR's report are often
12 inconsistent or incompatible with data collected by county
13 police departments and prosecutors; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban
16 Development requires organizations participating in the
17 Continuum of Care Program to establish and operate a coordinated
18 entry system to promote more effective access to services; and

19
20 WHEREAS, to meet this requirement, organizations in the
21 State, such as Partners in Care, have implemented the
22 Coordinated Entry System and Homelessness Management Information
23 System, both of which allow service providers to coordinate
24 care; and

26 WHEREAS, the Department of Health similarly operates the
27 Hawaii Coordinated Access Resource Entry System to ensure
28 consistent access to care and universal intake standards across



1 substance use disorder support service providers within the
2 State; and

3
4 WHEREAS, a similar coordinated data entry system that
5 incorporates information gathered by DCR and county police
6 departments and prosecutors would permit more effective tracking
7 of detainees and afford greater access to rehabilitative
8 programs and other resources; now, therefore,

9
10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third
11 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2026, the
12 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
13 Corrections and Rehabilitation (DCR) is requested to establish a
14 coordinated data entry system for DCR and county police
15 departments and prosecutors to track the status of detainees
16 incarcerated in DCR facilities; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DCR is requested to submit a
19 report of its findings, including any proposed legislation, to
20 the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
21 of the Regular Session of 2027; and

22
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DCR is requested to include in
24 its report:

26 (1) The implementation status of the coordinated data
27 entry system;

29 (2) Any estimated costs necessary for the establishment,
30 implementation, or maintenance of the coordinated data
31 entry system; and

33 (3) The number of county police departments and
34 prosecutors participating in the coordinated data
35 entry system; and

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
38 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
