SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO COORDINATE THE TRANSFER OF SMALL BOAT HARBORS BACK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND TO ESTABLISH A MANAGEMENT TEAM TO DEVELOP TRANSITION PLANS.

1 WHEREAS, Act 272, Session Laws of Hawaii 1991 (Act 272),
2 transferred the administration of the State's small boat harbors
3 from the Department of Transportation to the Department of Land
4 and Natural Resources; and

5
6 WHEREAS, Act 272 included transition provisions requiring
7 the establishment of a joint management team to ensure
8 continuity of operations, personnel alignment, and
9 administrative readiness during the transfer period; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the Legislature now seeks to return the small boat
12 harbor program to the Department of Transportation to better
13 align harbor planning, capital programming, operations, and
14 maintenance with the State's integrated, multimodal
15 transportation system; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the transfer of authority, staff, operations, and
18 assets requires a structured transition process, sufficient lead
19 time, and clear accountability to ensure uninterrupted services
20 and responsible stewardship of public resources; and

21
22 WHEREAS, while the transfer of full regulatory authority,
23 responsibilities, and jurisdiction over the State's small boat
24 harbors would require statutory amendments through the enactment
25 of laws, the Legislature finds value in initiating coordinated
26 planning to ensure that any prospective transition proceeds in
27 an orderly and informed manner; now, therefore,

29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third
30 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2026,



1 that the Department of Transportation and Department of Land and
 2 Natural Resources are requested to coordinate the transfer of
 3 all authority, responsibilities, positions, staff, operations,
 4 programs, assets, funds, and accounts associated with the
 5 State's small boat harbors back to the Department of
 6 Transportation; and
 7

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Transportation
 9 and Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources are
 10 requested to establish a management team to coordinate the
 11 transfer; and
 12

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Transportation
 14 and Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources are
 15 requested to designate or assign necessary staff to support the
 16 management team in developing and implementing transition plans;
 17 and
 18

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the management team is
 20 requested to develop transition and implementation plans
 21 necessary to ensure that the transferred functions and personnel
 22 are operational within the Department of Transportation,
 23 including, at a minimum:
 24

- 25 (1) Reworking position descriptions and reviewing
 26 personnel classifications;
 27
- 28 (2) Developing an organizational structure for
 29 administering small boat harbors within the Department
 30 of Transportation; and
 31
- 32 (3) Addressing operational, administrative, and
 33 personnel-related matters necessary for an orderly
 34 transfer; and


36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the management team is
 37 requested to submit a report of its findings and
 38 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
 39 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
 40 the Regular Session of 2027; and
