Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Allen Martin for service on the Elevator Mechanics Licensing Board.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the reappointment of Allen Martin from the Elevator Mechanics Licensing Board.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Martin's experience on the Elevator Mechanics Licensing Board qualify him for reappointment to the Board as a public member.
