Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 2110, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO AGRICULTURE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish and appropriate funds for a Conservation Agriculture and Soil Health Incentive Program within the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission; and
- (2) Require the Commission to submit annual reports and triennial program evaluations to the Legislature.
