Madame:

Your Committee on Education, to which was referred S.B. No. 2615 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOL CAFETERIA MEAL COSTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of Education to charge no less than one-quarter of the cost of preparing a school meal for each school meal.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of the Governor; Hawai'i Public Health Institute; Healthy Eating, Active Living Coalition; Democratic Party of Hawai'i Education Caucus; Hawai'i Food+ Policy; and one individual.

Your Committee finds that access to nutritious meals is essential for students' academic achievement and overall health. However, increasing school meal costs impose a significant burden on families, resulting in reduced student participation in school meal programs. This measure aims to decrease the required meal cost offset collection and enhance affordability of school meals within Department of Education schools.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

(1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 3000; and



- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.
