Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 3324, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MEDICAID,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Appropriate funds to the Department of Human Services to increase funding for certain Medicaid home- and community-based services, including residential services offered in community care foster family homes and expanded adult residential care homes; and
- (2) Require the Department to obtain matching federal funds and to pursue additional funding sources.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Human Services; Executive Office on Aging; Hawai'i State Council on Developmental Disabilities; Disability and Communication Access Board; AARP Hawai'i; Hawaii Disability Rights Center; Hawaii Medical Association; Sebastian's ARCH LLC; Adult Foster Homecare Association of Hawaii; AlohaCare; and four individuals.
