SB 2071 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HOUSING. Clarifies that the dwelling units eligible for the Rent-to-Own Program shall be units that are for sale in fee simple or leasehold on state or county land under a lease with an initial term of not less than 99 years. Increases the time period that the sales price of the dwelling units under the Rent-to Own Program shall remain fixed from 5 years to 10 years after the rental agreement is executed. SB 2191 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LIMITED-PROFIT HOUSING ASSOCIATIONS. Establishes an organizational, tax, and regulatory framework for limited-profit housing associations. Establishes the Limited-Profit Housing Council to oversee limited-profit housing associations. Effective 7/1/2050.	HOU/CPN, WAM/JDC
SB 2197 Status & Testimony	RELATED TO HOUSING. Replaces the five-year period during which the sales price of a rent-to-own dwelling unit shall remain fixed with an option period established by the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation. Effective 7/1/2050.	HOU/CPN, WAM/JDC

RELATING TO DEPOSITS OF PUBLIC FUNDS.

Requires the Director of Finance to consider, before the selection of a depository for the state treasury, the beneficial effects to the State of using depositories within the State, including but not limited to lending at favorable terms for the creation of certain affordable housing units. Effective 7/1/2050.

RELATING TO HOUSING DISCRIMINATION.

CPN/HOU, JDC

Allows the Hawaii Civil Rights Commission to prosecute discrimination based on source of income in housing cases.
