RELATING TO A BLUE ECONOMY.

EDT/AEN, WAM

Establishes the Blue Economy Working Group to study how to develop and support marine-based economic activities that align with the State's decarbonization and restorative food production goals. Requires a report to the Legislature.

RELATING TO MARINE AFFAIRS.

EDT/AEN, WAM

Declares that the State is an ocean cluster. Establishes the Office of Marine Affairs under the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation for administrative purposes only. Establishes the Marine Affairs Coordinator position. Requires the Marine Affairs Coordinator to submit annual reports to the Governor and Legislature. Transfers the employees and functions of the Governor's Advisory Committee on Marine Affairs to the Office of Marine Affairs. Appropriates funds for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) Marine Affairs Coordinator position.

RELATING TO THE AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT  
CORPORATION.

EDT/AEN, WAM

Requires the Agribusiness Development Corporation of the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to lease, license, or rent its properties at market rates or higher. Exempts lessees, licensees, and tenants who grow, raise, and harvest fresh local agricultural products for the Department of Education. Exempts partner members of the Food and Product Innovation Network.
