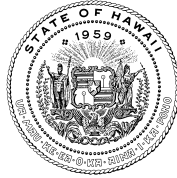

S.B. 3067, S.D. 1, H.D. 1

RELATING TO RECORDS

Chair Todd, Vice Chair Takenouchi, and Members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony on this measure.

The Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) strongly **supports** S.B. 3067, S.D. 1, H.D. 1 which removes outdated requirements for plans filed with the registrar's office, updates the statutory fee schedule, grants additional discretion to DAGS to approve the format of plans, and updates permissible drawing scales used in plans.

S.B. 3067, S.D. 1, H.D. 1 is a DAGS administrative measure which makes housekeeping amendments that remove outdated requirements, updates the fee schedule, and grants additional discretion to DAGS - which will improve overall operations of the division.

DAGS respectfully requests that the Committee amend the effective date of this measure to “upon approval.” Providing an immediate effective date will ensure that the Department can implement the provisions of this bill without delay and begin addressing the operational needs.
