I strongly support SB3275 because as a 79 year old Hawai'i resident since 1981, I need low dose cannabis to address my pains reflecting my arthritis (two different varieties), fibromyalgia, high blood pressure, pre-diabetis, the two titanium rods in my heel and various aches and pains from living an active and enjoyable life.

Unfortunately, I can't smoke so the tokes, cigarettes are not available to me. The low dose gummies are my saving natural herb that make life liveable. The Big Pharma prescriptions turned me into a bed case and one particular RX caused me to blank out and fall. I have a long list of concussions and one contusion. This is no way to live. Once I stopped the RX gradually, I haven't had another trip to the ER which saves time for other accident victims. My life has been good and no ER visits since November 2025.

I understand how abuse of cannabis can lead to addiction and those patients could better be served to address the abuse in their lives with therapy and less stress so that they don't turn to abuse of this natural healing herb.

What I don't understand is that in the last years of my life, I'm being denied cannabis for relief of pain. This is a violation of my Civil Rights to relieve pain. As a Masters Level Social Worker, I have an educated background to help others. Now I want and need help for my last years. Shortly, I will be 80 years old. At this stage of my life I want to manage my life.
