The Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) supports SCR 200, which requests the Department to implement a micro-credential pilot program.

The Department has been working in collaboration with the Hawaii State Teachers Association (HSTA) to recognize a vetted list of National Education Association (NEA) micro-credentials for professional development credit toward teacher reclassification.

The Department is preparing to implement and advertise the availability of NEA micro-credentials through a pilot program for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year after completion of the consultation process with the HSTA. The Department intends to track utilization of NEA micro-credentials and will report on the progress of this pilot program as requested in this resolution.
