A Bill for an Act Relating to the Establishment of Hawaii Ponoī as the Official State Song.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to designate "Hawaii Ponoī" as the official state song of the State of Hawaii.

SECTION 2. Chapter 14 of the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1955 is amended by adding the following new section to read as follows:

"Sec. 14-5.4. State song. The song "Hawaii Ponoī" is hereby adopted, established, and designated as the official song of the State, to be effective for as long as the legislature of the State does not otherwise provide."

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
