ACT 67

A Bill for an Act to Amend Section 286-54, Hawaii Revised Statues, Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles Duly Registered in another State or Country.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. The fourth paragraph of Section 286-54 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No nonresident owner of a motor vehicle which has been duly registered for the current year in the state or country of which he is a resident shall operate

any such vehicle or cause or permit to be operated upon the public highways, either before or while it is registered under this section, unless there is at all times displayed thereon the registration number plates assigned to the vehicle for the current calendar year by the state or country of which the owner is a resident, nor unless the certificate of registration when issued thereto, is placed in a certificate holder and securly fasten the same in plain sight within the driver's compartment of the vehicle for which the certificate is issued, or in the event the vehicle is a motorcycle, carry such certificate of registration in the tool bag or other convenient receptacle attached to the vehicle. The treasurer shall also furnish the owner with an emblem bearing a serial number with the words "VEHICLE PERMIT" and the date of expiration of such emblem to be placed on the rear bumper in plain sight of such vehicle, or when issued to a motorcycle emblem to be placed on rear fender."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing the Act, the revisor of statutes may exclude the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.*

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1972. (Approved May 17, 1971.)
