A Bill for an Act Relating to State Law Enforcement.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION I. Section 28-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 28-11.5 State law enforcement officers; appointment and powers. Employees of the department of the attorney general engaged as state law enforcement officers, upon specific authorization and direction of the attorney general, shall have all of the powers of police officers, including the power of arrest; provided that such powers shall remain in force and effect only while the state law enforcement officers are in actual performance of their duties as state law enforcement officers which duties shall include off-duty employment when such employment is for other state departments or agencies."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this Act, the revisor of statutes need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.*

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. (Approved June 1, 1978.)
