ACT 143 H.B. NO. 2103-84

A Bill for an Act Relating to Licensees Under the Intoxicating Liquor Law. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 281-44, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"§281-44 [Advertising] <u>Advertisements and signs</u> upon licensed premises. (a) All licensed premises shall post a sign in or about the premises containing and notifying all customers and other persons of the penalties of driving under the influence of intoxicating liquor under section 291-4. The sign shall be conspicuously positioned in order to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

(b) The liquor commission may prescribe the character and extent of all <u>other</u> advertisements, posters, or signs which may be posted or maintained in or about the licensed premises."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
