## ACT 108

S.B. NO. 651

A Bill for an Act Relating to Historic Preservation.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending the definition of "Historic property" to read as follows:

""Historic property"<sup>1</sup> means any building, structure, object, district, area, or site, including <u>heiau and</u> underwater site, that is significant in the history, architecture, archaeology, or culture of this State, its communities or the nation."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
