H.B. NO. 2436-86

A Bill for an Act Relating to Environmental Quality.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:*

SECTION 1. Act 275, Session Laws of Hawaii, 1984, as amended by Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii, 1985, is amended by amending subsection (f) of Section 1 to read as follows:

“(f) Advisory committee. There shall be established a technical advisory committee on pesticides to assist and advise the office in carrying out the purposes of this Act. The committee shall be composed of the chairperson of the environmental council, one representative each from the department of agriculture, the department of health, the department of land and natural resources, the Honolulu board of water supply, and the University of Hawaii, and five at-large members representing a mixture of disciplines and including at least one member each from the U.S. military in Hawaii, the agricultural industry, the structural pest control industry, an environmental organization, and a community organization. Members of the advisory committee other [that] than<sup>1</sup> the military representative shall be appointed by the governor in accordance with section 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The representative of the U.S. military shall be invited to serve without necessity of appointment by the governor. The committee shall be chaired by the director or the director’s designated representative.”

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
