A Bill for an Act Relating to the Child Support Enforcement Agency.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 576D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) The agency shall collect and disburse child support payments when a court order requires the collection and disbursal. <u>Notwithstanding</u> any other law to the contrary, the agency shall maintain a special interest bearing account for child support payments. Moneys collected by the agency for child support payments shall not be deposited into the state treasury, but shall be deposited into this account. Moneys to be disbursed by the agency for child support payments shall be disbursed from this account and the interest realized from the account shall be expended solely for purposes of administration of the child support program."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
