

ACT 105

H.B. NO. 3574

A Bill for an Act Making An Appropriation to the Department of the Attorney General.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$449,493.79, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 1988-1989, to the department of the attorney general to pay the balance of the contingent fee and expenses of the law firm of Nash, Railsback and Plessner, in the sum of \$363,450.27, for work it did on behalf of the State in connection with the case of United States v. Exxon Corp. plus interest at the rate of nine percent on the balance of \$363,450.27 for the period from August 7, 1986, until payment.

SECTION 2. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
