S.B. NO. 1336

A Bill for an Act Relating to Statewide Center for Students with Hearing and Visual Impairments.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 297-47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"[[]§297-47[]] House parents; [Hawaii School for the Deaf and the Blind.] statewide center for students with hearing and visual impairments. All house parents at the [Hawaii School for the Deaf and the Blind] statewide center for students with hearing and visual impairments employed in the department of education shall be employed under chapter 76 and shall have their compensation fixed in accordance with chapter 77, and the monthly rates of basic compensation so determined shall be payable for employment over a twelvemonth period. All house parents shall be employed for twelve months on a full-time basis."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
