H.B. NO. 928

A Bill for an Act Relating to Tort Reform.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Act 2, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii 1986, as amended by section 2 of Act 300, Session Laws of Hawaii 1989, as amended by section 1 of Act 62, Session Laws of Hawaii 1991, is amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 31. This Act shall take effect upon its approval, and Sections 2 [to], 4, 5, 6, 7, [Section] 17, and [Section] 20 shall be repealed on October 1, [1993] 1995.”

SECTION 2. The auditor shall conduct a study to review the effects of tort reform in Hawaii and to determine whether Act 2, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii¹ should become permanent. The auditor shall submit its findings and recommendations no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 1995.

SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
