A Bill for an Act Relating to Native Hawaiians.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 212, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, is amended as follows:

1. By amending subsection (c) to read:

"(c) The advisory committee shall submit a written interim report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2008 regular session. The advisory committee shall submit [a written final report] annual reports of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2009 regular session[-] and no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2010 regular session. The advisory committee shall submit its final report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2010 regular session. The advisory committee shall submit its final report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2011 legislative session."

2. By amending subsection (e) to read:

"(e) The 'aha kiole advisory committee shall cease to exist on June 30, [2009.] 2011."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

(Became law on April 30, 2009, without the Governor's signature, pursuant to Art. III, §16, State Constitution.)
