A Bill for an Act Relating to the Cytomegalovirus. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Hawaii:

SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§321-Cytomegalovirus public education. (a) The department of health shall provide public education to inform pregnant women and women who may become pregnant regarding:

- The transmission of the cytomegalovirus to pregnant women and (1) women who may become pregnant;
- (2)
- Birth defects caused by congenital cytomegalovirus; Methods of diagnosing congenital cytomegalovirus; and (3)
- (4) Available preventative measures.

The department of health shall provide the information described in (b) subsection (a) to:

- Hospitals licensed pursuant to section 321-14.5; (1)
- (2) Health care providers offering care to pregnant women and infants;
- Registered family child care homes; (3)
- Licensed group child care centers; (4)
- (Ś) Licensed group child care homes;
- Licensed infant and toddler child care centers; and (6)
- (7) Religious, ecclesiastical, or denominational organizations offering children's programs as a part of worship services."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.¹

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015. (Approved July 13, 2015.)
