SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE ON CONFERENCE TO CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO
MEET THE GOVERNOR'S OBJECTIONS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1191
S.D.2, H.D.2, C.D.1.

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 16 of article III of the
2 Constitution of the State of Hawaii, on or before noon on the
3 forty-fifth day after adjournment sine die of a session, the
4 legislature may convene in special session for the sole purpose
5 of acting upon any bill returned by the governor with the
6 governor's objections; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the governor by proclamations has given notice of
9 her intent to return certain bills and has further requested
10 that the legislature consider amendments to certain bills; and

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 16 of article III of the State
13 Constitution, during a special session convened on the forty-
14 fifth day, the legislature may amend any returned bill to meet
15 the governor's objections; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Special Session of 2007, the
19 House of Representatives concurring, that a committee on
20 conference be established to consider the governor's objections
21 and possible amendments to meet those objections to Senate Bill
22 No. 1191 S.D.2, H.D.2, C.D.1.
