Your Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection, to which was referred Governor's Message No. 20, submitting for study and consideration the nomination of:

begs leave to report as follows:

Your Committee has reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by the nominee and finds Quenton Brown to possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated to the State Boxing Commission of Hawaii.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination of Quenton Brown from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and nine individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Brown's background, experience, and passion for the sport of boxing qualify him for appointment to the State Boxing Commission of Hawaii. Your Committee notes that Mr. Brown has over thirty years of experience at the amateur and professional levels, including past membership on the USA boxing team, six state Golden Glove championships, and fighting against four world champions. Mr. Brown has indicated a desire to increase interest amongst young people in the sport and a desire to help bring professional boxing back to Hawaii. Your Committee further finds that Mr. Brown has served as an interim member of the State Boxing



Commission of Hawaii since June 2013, has a thorough understanding of the role and responsibilities of commission members, and has been appointed to the State Boxing Commission of Hawaii based on his knowledge, experience, and desire to contribute to the community.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection that is attached to this report, your Committee, after full consideration of the background, experience, and qualifications of the nominee, has found the nominee to be qualified for the position to which nominated and recommends that the Senate advise and consent to the nomination.
